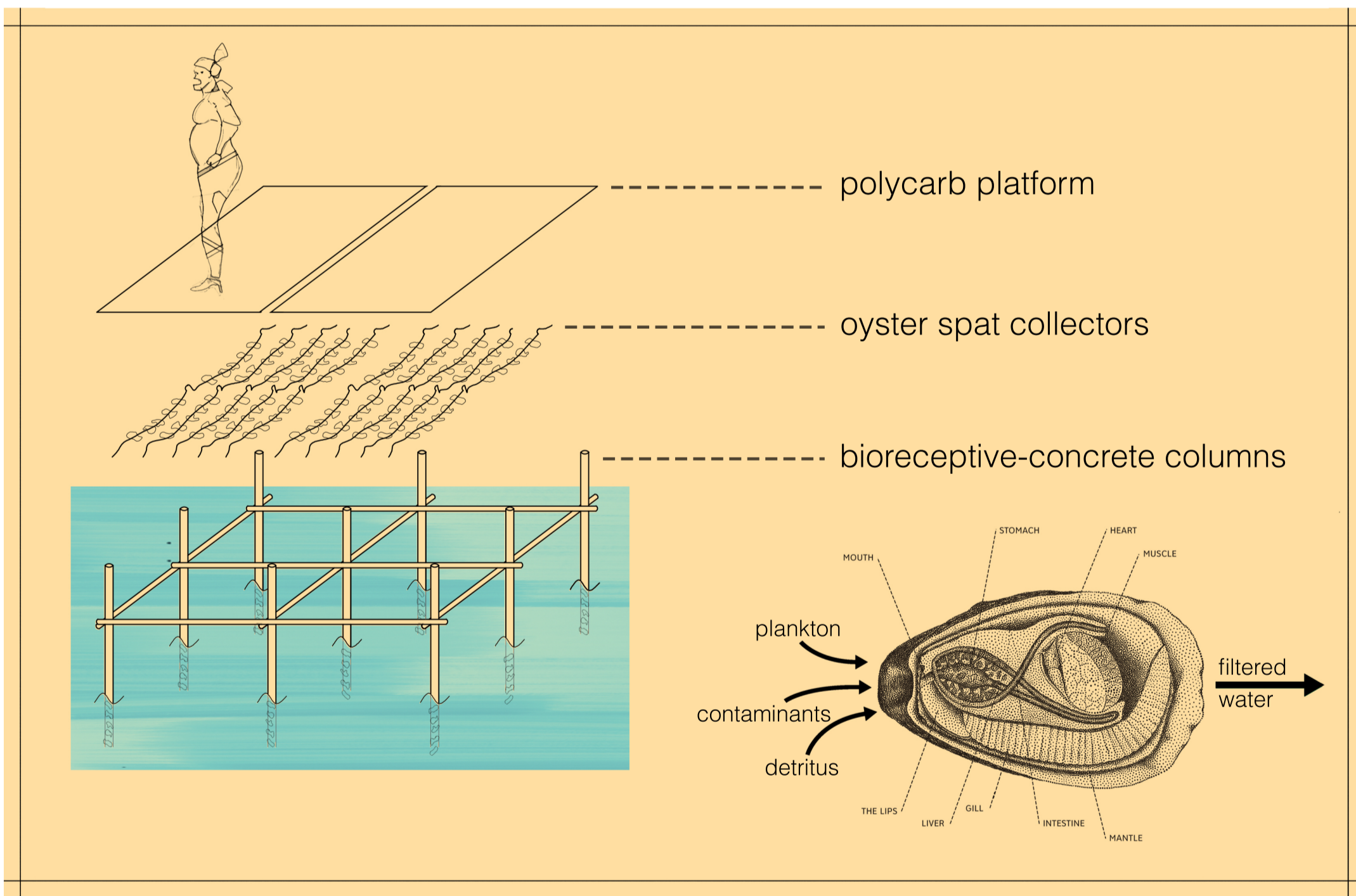
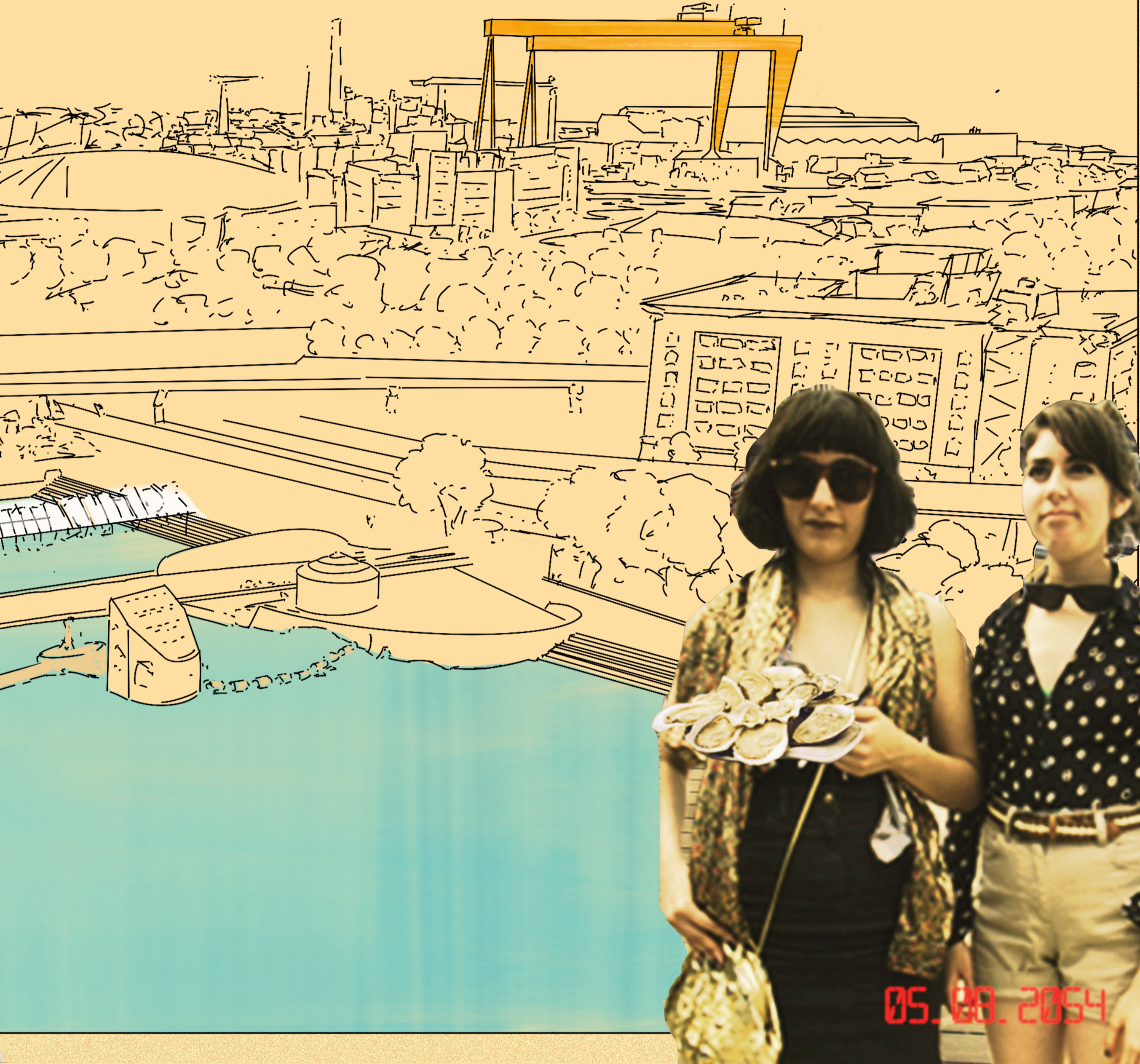


# OYSTER SAYS YEEO



## Oyster Says Yeoo!

Water quality in Northern Ireland is in crisis. Algal blooms, sewage spills, and dying ecosystems mark our Super Wicked Problem. Oyster Says Yeoo proposes a playful yet restorative response: a bioreceptive-concrete column module placed beside Queens Quay, seeded with native oysters to filter and heal the harbour water. Each oyster cleans up to 200 litres of water a day, improving clarity, biodiversity, and resilience. Working with an ecologist, the site will nurture early reef growth and test future expansion. Inspired by successful reef projects in Manhattan and Staten Island, this first module could grow into an expanding reef network across Belfast's harbour. Over time, the oysters could even feed the city, closing the loop between ecology and community.
